

Declaration of an Active RN Multistate License as the Underlying Credential for a Washington State ARNP

In accordance with the passing of [Substitute Senate Bill 5499](#) Multistate Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC), beginning July 24, 2023, nurses with an active multistate registered nurse (RN) or licensed practical nurse license (LPN) issued from another state can practice in Washington state. If you hold an active advanced registered nurse practitioner (ARNP) license in Washington state and hold an active RN multistate license, the RN multistate license is recognized as an approved underlying RN license and you will not need to renew your Washington state RN license.

Please complete the form below to indicate where the active RN multistate license is held, the multistate license number, and acknowledgment that you will not be renewing your Washington state RN license. I declare that I hold an active RN multistate license in another state and will not be renewing my Washington state RN license. I am requesting for my Washington state RN license status to reflect "Expired WA- Active MSL".

Please note: It is the responsibility of each nurse to maintain the active multistate license in another state and to meet all other requirements to renew the Washington state ARNP license, including submitting updated proof of an active national certification consistent with WAC 246-840-302 and WAC 246-840-360.
