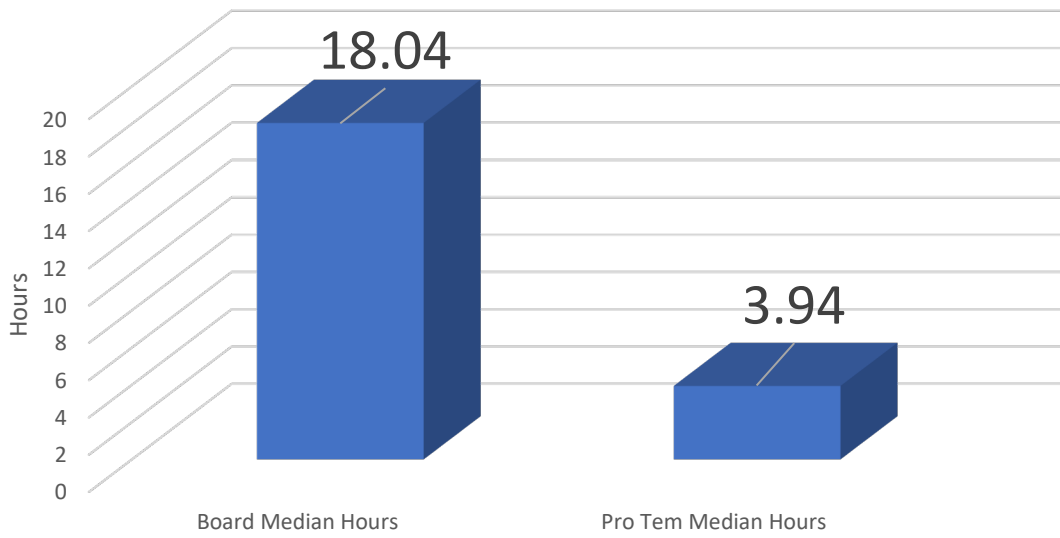
Pro Tem Board Members

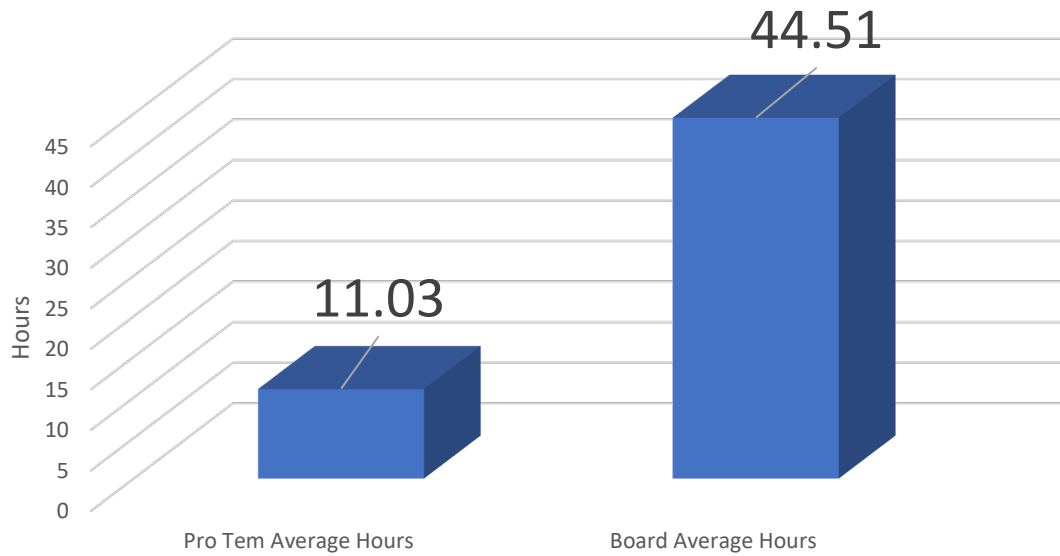
Their experience and participation are critical in state policy development and regulation.

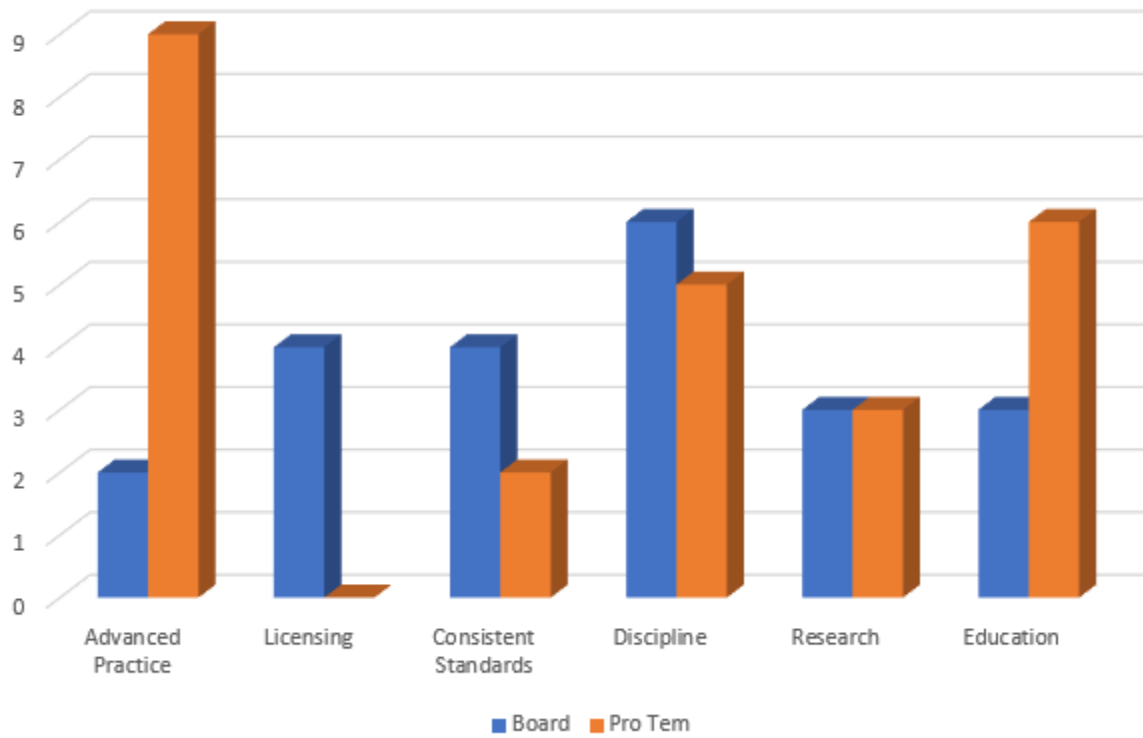
Board Member Hours per Month
