Washington <u>Single-State</u> License	Washington <u>Multistate</u> License (MSL)
Allows practice in Washington State only.	Allows practice in Washington State and 40 other participating compact states.
<b>Initial License Fee:</b> \$138 for RN, \$93 for LPN	<b>Initial License Fee:</b> \$203 for RN, \$158 for LPN
<b>Annual Renewal Fee:</b> \$138 for RN, \$93 for LPN	<b>Annual Renewal Fee:</b> \$158 for RN, \$113 for LPN
<b>Initial License Requirements for Applicants Educated Outside of the US:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Application and fee</li> <li>• Transcript evaluation from a BON approved evaluation service provider</li> <li>• English proficiency exam (if applicable)</li> <li>• Pass NCLEX</li> <li>• Verification of an active license in another US state and passing NCLEX results (if endorsing from another state)</li> <li>• FBI fingerprint background check (if out of state address)</li> </ul>	<b>Initial License Requirements for Applicants Educated Outside of the US:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Application and fee</li> <li>• Transcript evaluation from a BON approved evaluation service provider</li> <li>• English proficiency exam (if applicable)</li> <li>• Pass NCLEX</li> <li>• Verification of an active license in another US state and passing NCLEX results (if endorsing from another state)</li> <li>• FBI fingerprint background check</li> <li>• Valid US Social Security Number</li> <li>• WA State must be primary state of residence (PSOR)</li> <li>• Must not be a participant in an alternative to discipline program or have ever been convicted of a felony.</li> </ul>
