

Explore clinical placement options

- Keep communications open with your refresher program as they are a support to you and you want to make sure they have final approval of the clinical site.
- Collaborate with your refresher program staff and clinical placement groups to explore potential placement opportunities.

- Call the education unit(s) of the facilities where you have interest in securing clinical placement. Be prepared to explain why you are interested in a clinical placement in the facility (e.g., potential employee, mission/vision match), clinical requirements (e.g., number of required hours, specific population focus, time-frame for completion of hours), and clinical goals (e.g., specific outcomes for the course).
- Be flexible! Be sure to consider availability across all shifts and days of the week.
- Be clear with your request and offer to send a follow-up email to provide the details in written format.
- Include an up-to-date resume with your follow-up email.
- Include the refresher program WAC with the follow-up email.
- Be prepared to discuss potential facility requirements (e.g., CPR, immunizations).
- Consider addressing <u>WAC 246-840-563</u> (11) The refresher course shall ensure all students have clinical practice experiences with the refresher course program.
