

Request for Washington Single State Licensure Attestation

In accordance with [Chapter 18.80 RCW](#) Interstate Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC), nurses with an active multistate registered nurse (RN) or licensed practical nurse (LPN) license can practice in Washington state.

If you are requesting to convert your Washington multistate license (MSL) to a Washington single state license, please complete the attestation below and email to nursing@doh.wa.gov.

If you have applied for a Washington multistate license and do not meet the MSL requirements and would like to request a Washington single state license, please complete the attestation below and email to nursing@doh.wa.gov.

If you have an active MSL in another state, you may practice in Washington state with your MSL. You may only hold one active MSL at a time. Your MSL must be issued in your primary state of residence (PSOR). For additional information on the NLC, MSLs, or PSOR, please visit www.nursecompact.com.
