

HELMS is the new online portal available to healthcare providers for submitting applications, renewals, status changes, and account updates. All Washington state nurses and nursing applicants need to <u>create a HELMS portal account</u>.

# Create, connect, and use your HELMS account

# Step 1: Find your license number before you start

Use <u>Provider Credential Search</u> to find your license number if you don't have it available.

#### Step 2: Use a desktop computer

Use a desktop computer – mobile and tablet users have experienced error messages.

## Step 3: Access your SAW account

Create a <u>Secure Access Washington (SAW)</u> account or log in to your existing account.

Note: Please don't use the old DOH portal because it will no longer work.

#### **Step 4: Add HELMS to your portal (first time only)**

- · Click the "Add a New Service" button
- Add by agency
- · Click "Department of Health"
- Add the "Health Professional and Facility Licensing (HELMS)" service to your
  SAW account

#### **Step 5: Navigating HELMS**

Download or print the complete <u>Guide to Using Your HELMS Portal</u>.

- For renewals, scroll down for the renewal button
- For new applications only, click on the top button

### Step 6: Complete your demographic data survey

Submit your demographic data in compliance with state law.

Under <u>RCW 18.130.042</u> all licensed health care professionals in Washington are required to provide demographic and workforce data during initial licensure and renewal.

#### Step 7: Do you need a receipt?

Navigate to your <u>HELMS portal homepage</u> and select "Payments," "History," and "Download Receipt."

# Step 8: Renewal notices are now digital

Renewal notices will be emailed about 90 days prior to your renewal due date.

# **Step 9: Check the status of your application** or renewal anytime

Log in to your <u>HELMS account through SAW</u> and check the status column next to your credentials on the homepage.
